There is an option for students to lease one from College on an annual basis.



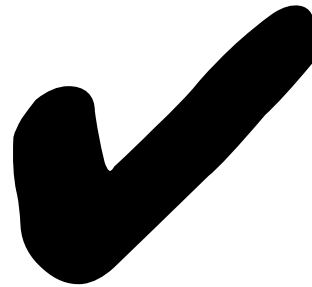


Plain white or navy blue or black t-shirt (without logo) may be worn under the shirt providing it is only visible at the neck

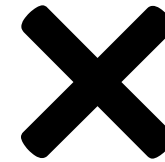




Plain black or brown lace up, slip on or buckled T bar style



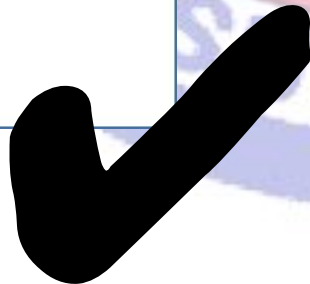
The following are not permitted:

• Boots - shoes must come below the ankle bone





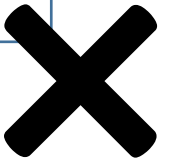
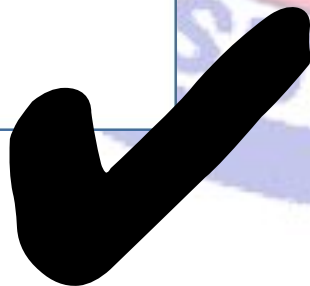
College regulation V neck jersey.

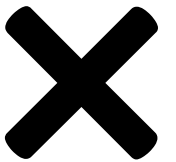

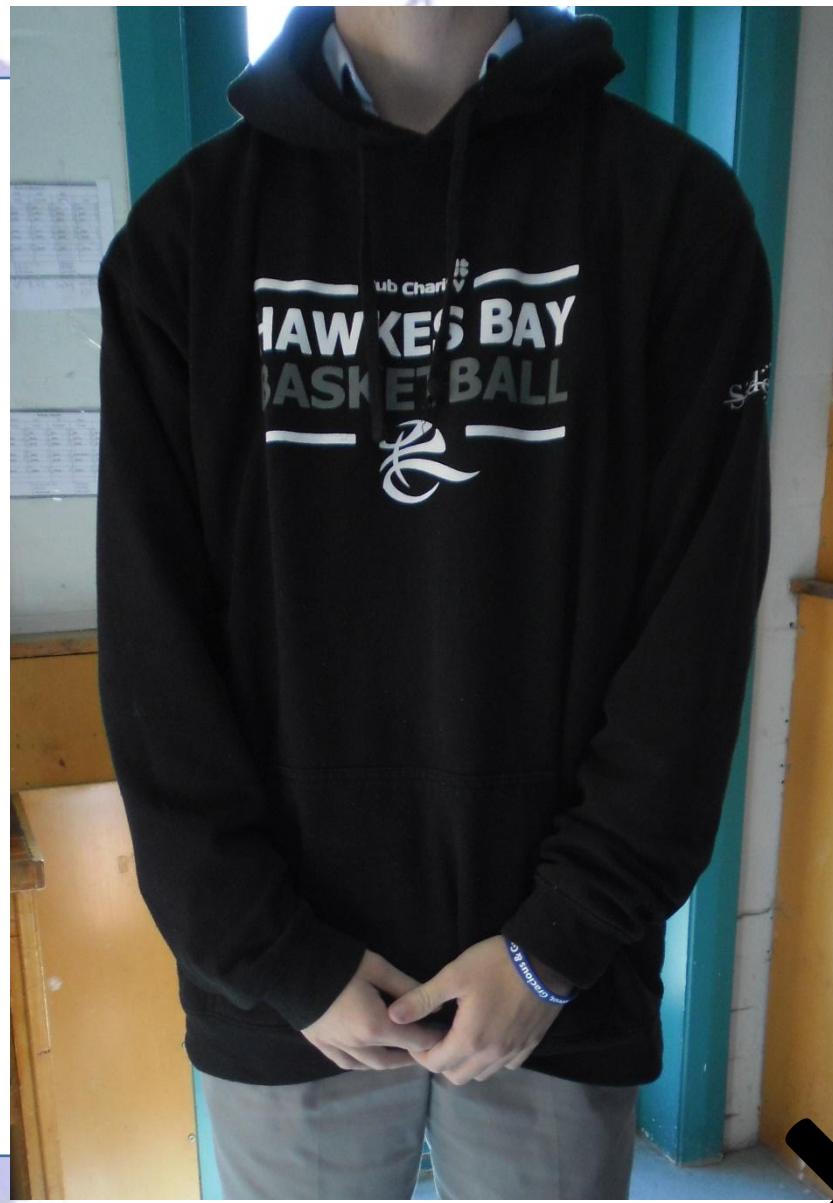

College team

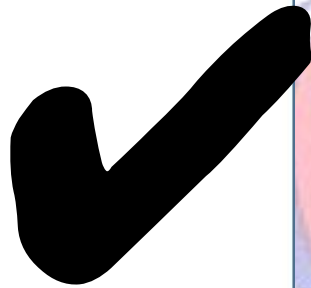

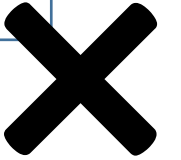
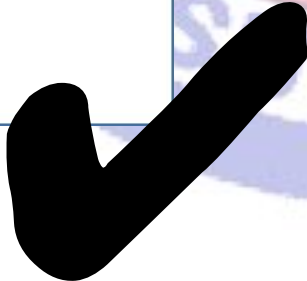
